Jesus Christ, even though He is God, did not count equality with God. This is a great sign of humility. He was obedient to the will of the Father to the point of dying like a thief on the cross.

To be humble, you have to bring yourself very low. When you do this, God will lift you up. Mary is queen and Jesus is king in heaven and on earth because they did the will of God out of humility. On the other way round, Lucifer who was proud was cast out of heaven. Pride only leads to destruction. Allow God to raise you. If you raise yourself, you will fall terribly.

Let us meditate on the following verse from Sirach: "My son, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved by those who are acceptable to God. The greater you are, the more you should humble yourself, and thus you will find favour with God. For great is the power of the lord, it is the humble who give him glory. Do not seek what is beyond your powers, nor search into what is beyond your reach." Sirach 3:17-21

luke 3:7-9

"John said to the crowd who came out to be baptized by him," You brood of vipers! Who told you that you can escape the divine punishment that is to come? Produce now the fruits of a true change of heart, and do not deceive yourself by saying: 'we are sons of Abraham.' for I tell you, God can raise children for Abraham from these stones. The axe is already laid to the root of the tree and every tree that fails to produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire" luke 3:7-9

In the verse from the book of Luke above, we can see John, talking to the Pharisees who came to be baptized. The book of Jeremiah 7:1-11 says: " This is the word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD: "Stand at the gate of the LORD'S house and there proclaim this message: "'Hear the word of the LORD, all you people of Judah who come through these gates to worship the LORD. This is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says: Reform your ways and your actions, and I will let you live in this place. Do not trust in deceptive words and say, "This is the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD!"

If you really change your ways and your actions and deal with each other justly, if you do not oppress the alien, the fatherless or the widow and do not shed innocent blood in this place, and if you do not follow other gods to your own harm, then I will let you live in this place, in the land I gave your forefathers for ever and ever. But look, you are trusting in deceptive words that are worthless. "'Will you steal and murder, commit adultery and perjury, burn incense to Baal and follow other gods you have not known, and then come and stand before me in this house, which bears my Name, and say, "We are safe"--safe to do all these detestable things? Has this house, which bears my Name, become a den of robbers to you? But I have been watching! declares the LORD."

Going to church does not bring about automatic ticket to heaven. We need to be Holy in secret and in public and have a clean heart and clear conscience. Many are doing evil and are hiding or posing as saints in the church and public. It is disheartening that the church of God is filled with so many people who live a life of hypocrisy. If we amend our lives, the lord will dwell in our lands which is our lives, and our worship will become true and genuine worship.

**John 6:51**

"I am the living bread which has come down from heaven; whoever eats of this bread will live forever. The bread I shall give is my own flesh and I will give it for the life of the world." John 6:51

The questions to be asked today are:

Do we believe this word of Jesus?

What is the bread He was talking about?

Do you believe that Jesus Christ is the living bread that came down from heaven?

Jesus Christ is the bread that came down from heaven. The bread He is talking about is His own body and blood. This body and blood is the Eucharist which He instituted. At the reception of the Holy Eucharist, we receive the body and blood of Christ and these body and blood gives life to the body and to the soul.

Anyone who eats the body and blood of Christ have Christ in Him and Him in Christ; it is a strong renewed covenant between Jesus and the receiver and a great sign of God to man; God giving man His flesh as food because of the great love He has for man. He wants to sustain man personally and to dwell in Him.

Let us not take the Eucharist for granted because it is the greatest gift God left behind for us. It is the source of life and power, it is the source of strength and peace. If we want to have life, believe in the living bread and eat the living bread. The living bread and wine is real food and real drink. Let us not allow anything to hinder us from receiving the Eucharist as often as possible during mass.

Monday October 14th 2019

**MANTLES (1)**

**2nd Kings 2:9-14**

Sing with us: "The angels bow down in adoration, we join them now as we lift our voice we cry Holy, Holy is the Lamb. The angels bow down in adoration, we join them now as we lift our voice we cry Worthy, Worthy is the Lamb." Now, in one minute, pray and ask the the Lord to prepare your spirit, to open your inner eyes and then, deposit something substantial and tangible in you as we explore this subject.

Oh, happy are those who find fulfilment and comfort in the presence of His Majesty. How inexplicable and beautiful is the aurora of His presence! Dearly beloved, I warmly welcome to another day! Today, we would be looking closely at the subject, Mantles! In Bible days, a mantle was an outer cloak used for additional covering and warmth, especially at night. The mantle was essentially the only "blanket" the person had so even when used as a pledge the law required it be returned before bedtime. From the idea of something that "covers" in the natural, a mantle easily comes to represent spiritual covering also. Mantles usually refer to spiritual authority and anointing. They literally symbolize power, position, and authority that are given to men by God which also, can in turn, be handed over to others. Mantles were never meant to exit the earth realm! They possibly can be transferred but only to those who through diligence and by the discipline of prayer and other spiritual exercises have aligned themselves enough and presented themselves worthy and deserving, both to God and men, of such powerful divine endowment.

From the above we can see that there also exist a possibility for mantle(s) to die with the possessors. This happened in the case of Gehazi who through carelessness and greed brought a curse upon himself and lost his legal right (the mantle of Elisha), thereby, causing Elisha to expire with it. We see in the story of Elisha and Elijah the reward of perseverance, determination and diligence. Did Elisha really have to undergo such laborious journey with Elisha just because of a mantle? Why wasn't his desire granted at an instant? This is because all that is tangible in the kingdom is at an expensive cost. Elisha knew what he desired and never paid attention the various constrains that came along. Despite the discouragements, he never felt bad nor backed out. For him it was a matter of life and death. Eventually when they both crossed the river Jordan, the last phase, Elijah seeing the sobersidedness and doggedness of Elisha then said to him, "Tell me what you want

me to do for you before I am taken away." "Let me receive a double portion of your power that will make me your successor," Elisha answered. "That is a difficult request to grant," Elijah replied. "But you will receive it if you see me as I am being taken away from you; if you don't see me, you won't receive it." 2 Kings 2:9-10. Friend, see the series of tests that Elisha underwent just to procure the mantle. The last test, the most difficult, was the test of sight. "If only you can see me as I am being taken away from you..." said Elijah. What an arduous challenge! A trial that weighed the depth of the spiritual sensitivity and perception of Elisha. Dear, spiritual mantles aren't for babes. They are for 'matured' believers who have earnestly labored in the place of prayer and sacrifice and are equally spiritually discerning and sensitive. Tomorrow is another day!

## Prayer

1. Exalt the Lord for the gift of His Word.
2. Lord grant me the grace of perseverance and spiritual sensitivity.
3. Pray earnestly that the Lord deposits in you a magnanimous weight of His power.

Let's begin today's reflection with this powerful and Spirit-filled song by Tony Melendez, "King of Kings, Lord of lords, faithful and true, Lamb of God, we worship You. King of Kings, Lord of lords, faithful and true, Lamb of God we worship You. Praise the Bread of Life, Emmanuel, God with us, the One Who saves. Praise the Cup of Life that glorious stream that washes our sins away, that washes our sins away." It forever remains a special privilege to worship and venerate our God. What more can we do than to join the battalions of angels to glorify and bless His Majesty. It is in His presence that our spirits are refreshed and revived. From it we draw new life. Just bless the Name of the Lord for the next five (5) minutes with songs of worship and soak in that presence. Tell Him how helpless you are without Him. Declare your passionate love for Him, bless Him for there is none like Him.

The previous day, we looked into the subject of Mantles, defining what means, its significance and how we can become a possessor. And today, we are going to delve into and explore some other dimensions of procuring mantles.

Jesus said; "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go to the

Father." (John 14:12). Here, Jesus is about returning to the Father and as customary presents to His disciples His mantle of power and authority. The anointing that is in Jesus is available to his followers and his mantle is greater than any prophet in the Old Testament. Seeking these "ample" works may manifest in an individual life in many ways depending on the gifts of the Holy Spirit deposited in them. The Holy Ghost is the one through which these works can be performed. He is the being that accords us the mantles we seek and desire. He is that promise of the Father, the seat of God's power who grants authority and power to those who are sincere and ready to do business with God and conquer the world for Christ. One may have a healing anointing, another, a deliverance anointing, another, a gift of evangelism or gift of helps or administration. The mantle that you seek is usually the mantle that God wishes to impart. What about the idea of passing a mantle from one person to another? Yes, it still happens, even in this our age and time. If

God has placed someone in your life who is a giant in an area of Christian faith, you may seek to have their anointing and spiritual authority imparted to you. Maybe that is one of the reasons God has that person in your life. Remember though that the

anointing resident in them is really a measure of God's Holy Spirit given

to them by grace. Was this not the case with Moses and the seventy (70) leaders of Israel? This shows that mantles and graces of the Spirit are transferable but at a cost. They also always demand great responsibility. You have to be constantly aligned in the spirit to make efficacious and effective use of it. A large mantle is not for the faint hearted or the immature. Do you want one? Prepare yourself and go for it!

## Prayer

1. Take two songs of praise.
2. Pray as the Spirit leads.

Let's begin today's reflection with this powerful song: "It takes a lot of growing for a tree to reach the sky. It takes a lot of rain to help it grow. It takes a lot of running for a child to catch the wind. It takes a lot of walking to learn to run. And I'm growing in Jesus getting, stronger each and every day and in every way because Jesus is growing in me. Many times I felt discouraged when the rain got in my way. I didn't know that it could make me grow. And everytime I run ahead I always miss the turn. I end up walking back to what I've learned. And I'm growing in Jesus, getting stronger each and every day and in every way because Jesus is growing in me." Today, we would be examining the subject of Spiritual growth and all that it entails. Growth as we know has to do with increment, expansion, enlargement etc. In the Kingdom of God, our growth in the Spirit is measured and determined by two things and today, we shall be considering one of them. It isn't enough to just receive the life of Christ (being born-again) and then plateau at that realm. We must know that there is more and that much work need to be done in our lives as Christians in order for us to explore and partake of all that God has in store for us. We have to grow in the knowledge of God and His divine will for us. St Paul says, "For this reason we have always prayed for you, ever since we heard about you. We ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will, with all the wisdom and understanding that his Spirit gives. Then you will be able to live as the Lord wants and will always do what pleases him. Your lives will produce all kinds of good deeds, and you will grow in your knowledge of God. May you be made strong with all the strength which comes from his glorious power, so that you may be able to endure everything with patience. And with joy give thanks to the Father, who has made you fit to have your share of what God has reserved for his people in the kingdom of light." Colossians 1:9-11. Paul in his writing makes us understand that there is a provision in God's economy but that it entails becoming spiritually mature in order to bear much fruits and share in the glory that God has reserved. Your growth in the kingdom of God is measured by these:

[1] BY YOUR DEGREE OF CONFORMITY TO THE IMAGE OF THE CHRIST: More important than "possessing" is your "becoming." Many Christians are desperate to possess the gifts of the Spirit while neglecting the most important, the fruits of the Spirit. This is the reason the Church has so many anointed but spiritually immature believers. Our maturity is determined by the abundance of spiritual fruits and virtues that we possess, not just the gifts! 2nd Peter 1:4-8 says,

"In this way he has given us the very great and precious gifts he promised, so that by means of these gifts you may escape from the destructive lust that is in the world, and may come to share the divine nature. For this very reason do your best to add goodness to your faith; to your goodness add knowledge; to your knowledge add self-control; to your self-control add endurance; to your endurance add godliness; to your godliness add Christian affection; and to your Christian affection add love. These are the qualities you need, and if you have them in abundance, they will make you active and effective in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ." This is what is wanting in the Church today. It clearly shows that we haven't yet gotten to that point of maturity in the Spirit. It is very disastrous to possess the gifts when the fruits aren't in proper place. It will definitely make believers misbehave. We reflect who Christ truly is to the world, not necessarily by the show of our spiritual gifts but by the manifestation of the godly virtues that have been grounded in us by the Spirit of God. Christ never made such mistake, He taught the disciples on the matters of the kingdom, building them up and making them become another Him before releasing on them the power of the Spirit. We all are called to possess the fruits of God's Spirit and this is only possible through that agency called the Holy Spirit. It is by manifesting these virtues that we are known by the world as the true Children of God. We shall continue tomorrow!

Ephesians 4:13

Yesterday, we briefly examined the subject of spiritual growth. We were made to understand how believers grow into full maturity in the Kingdom and the agency that is solely responsible for this great and noble work. Luke 10:25-37

This topic is an attempt to open our inner eyes, to clearly reveal to us those persons who God have mandated us to love not only as ourselves but as Christ loved us. The question, "Who is my neighbor?" brought about the narration of the parable of the Good Samaritan by Jesus. We were made to understand that our neighbor isn't anyone that we wish to love and care for. No! He/she is anyone that we come in contact with in our everyday life, most especially those who are in dire need of help. As the saying goes, "Charity begins at home." Most believers tend to search for those who they regard as neighbors on the 'outskirts' while neglecting their first priorities- their very own family members and relatives. Our love should be sincere and unhyprocritical. Let us not abandon the inner part of the cup as we wash the external. This love must first be shown to those we are closely related to even before extending it to the outside. In the home, many are obviously denied love. It is not only destructive but also wicked to be obviously preferential in the home! Why must it be evident that you prefer a particular child to the other? Do you really know the psychological effect of the seed you are planting, the havoc you are causing? All must be loved equally and treated as one. As a husband/wife, how do you dispense this impartial love to your partner? How are you helping each other to become better persons? Parents (Stepdads and Moms), how do you treat that child that isn't biologically yours? What about your maidservant or manservant or even those working for you? As a child, how committed are you to loving your God-given parents or ward? Believers in Christ, it is our Christian duty to express the love of the Father that have been lavishly shown us to those around us, first, to our families and then, to "strangers." Beloved, does the welfare of your relatives matter to you? These people have been given to us by God and it is our Christian responsibility to provide for them if we truly can. In fact, this is how Apostle Paul puts it: "Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever." 1st Timothy 5:8. Isn't this really striking? But remember that in doing so, you must do with intelligence and wisdom because of how wicked the world is. Strangers aren't to be left aside too. The parable we considered today clearly expressed what true love is-

love that knows no bounds. Friend, will you continue to deny "them" love and even their legal rights because of their background or skin color? Tribal differences, status, religious beliefs, gender, race, physical features etc. should never stand as a hindrance to the dispensation of this Christlike love to people. People must be loved and helped beyond reasons. This is why we are Christians! This exactly is what the Word of God is saying today. You must make a firm resolution to love all just as Jesus loved and will continue to love you.

**THE POWER OF CONSISTENCY**  
2 Corinthians 3:18

Aristotle says, "We are what we repeatedly do. Excellence, then, is not an act, but a habit." Habit formation is the process by which a behaviour, through 'regular repetition' becomes automatic or habitual. We are what we repeatedly do, either good or bad. This is the power of consistency! A man does not become addicted to drinking just by taking two or three bottles of alcohol in one sitting. He only becomes an addict when he repeats the action over a long period of time (through this, he attracts the Spirit of alcoholism). This is same with prayer. Prayer warriors weren't always like this, you know. This were weak people who at a time couldn't even pray for just 10 minutes but now, could stretch and intercede for hours without getting tired. It wasn't easy at first but as a result the discipline they subjected themselves to, the Spirit of prayer was compelled to possess them. Many who are today helplessly addicted to all sorts of immoralities, be it lust, fornication, adultery, pornography and masturbation, homosexuality etc., we are not initially like this. They became addicted when they constantly gave themselves to the constant iteration of the evil action(s). It was the continuous repetition that attracted the demons of lust and perversion to take hold of them and today, these sins have become strongholds in their lives. No one attains mastery except by subscribing to the standard of consistency. God builds us into what he desires by subscribing us to this very standard. This standard continually prunes and sometimes, breaks and remoulds us until we become exactly that which He had in mind. Consider the talented footballers, golfers, newscasters, writers, musicians etc., these persons were once like you and me. The weren't outstanding like they are now and were victims of many failures. What then furnished them into what they are today? Nothing but intense discipline! They subjected themselves to all sorts of trainings which shaped them into what we celebrate today. If you want to be exceptional and irreplaceable in your field, then, you must practice consistently until you become an incontestable master. Even the Kingdom is not for babes! It is for people who continue to press till there aim is attained. Hear St. Paul: "I do not claim that I have already succeeded or have already become perfect. I keep striving to win the prize for which Christ Jesus has already won me to himself. Of course, my brothers and sisters, I really do not think that I have already won it; the one thing I do, however, is to forget what is behind me and do my best to reach what is ahead. So I run straight towards the goal in order to win the prize, which is God's call through Christ Jesus to the life above." In 2 Cor. 3:18, Paul says, "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being

transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord." This truly, my dear, is the power of consistency!

3. Ask Him to carry you along and keep you focused as you journey unto salvation.
4. Pour out to Him your heart desires.

Revelation 2:1-7

Where have that intimacy that you initially had with Christ evanesced to? What have swallowed up that fervent passion and desire that you once had for God and His things? Yes, it is very true that by God's grace, you are walking in virtue and have conquered the supposed 'sin factor' but still yet, the Lord has this against you. He admonishes you to repent and hesitate not in returning to that intimate relationship that once existed between you and Him. The Lord is passionate about having a relationship with you, how long would you continue to reject His proposal? Dear, can't you see that all have almost become cold? What happened to the times you met with God at midnights? What happened to the times you were passionate about knowing God? You no longer read God's Word for the purpose of gaining light and understanding but as a religious routine. It's not that you do not pray, you do, but just to feel spiritual. You no longer take the things of God serious and now derive satisfaction in frivolous and worthless things. Why, my beloved,

why have your love for God suddenly become sour and lukewarm? Your carelessness have given way and allowed the vain issues of life to choke up the things that really matter. Will you continue in this way, my friend? Jesus calls to you today, hearken to His voice. He wants you. He desires to have that fire rekindled in you once more. He extends His hands to you this day, will you reject His proposition? He repeats, "Turn from your sins and do what you did at first. CANKERWORM (1)**  
1st Corinthians 6:9

Today, we are going to be considering a very important subject that I believe requires urgent attention and examination. So many are frustrated and do not know what to do to establish victory over the mess they got themselves into. Oh, how many Christians have been plagued by this spiritual epidemic! No, we weren't like this before. We lived a consecrated life but now see how miserable and filthy we are. Many Christians are crying out to God for emancipation but it looks as if help has refused to come from Zion. No, I have come to you with the Word of the Lord, "There is indeed a way!" We fast and pray in sincerity for days, weeks and even months but are shocked at the speed/rate at which we return to the vomit we were making sincere efforts to quit. It's like we are bound in Chains that can never be broken. We run in circles despite all we do to find true liberation. How helpless we are! How powerful addiction can be! You must come to the knowledge of the fact that pornography and masturbation are spirits; deadly spirits from the bottomless pit of Hell. This spirits has been sent to plague our spiritual life, to bring us down from that spiritual acme. These spirits operate through lust. They entice you by what you see and hear and make you do that which is not only detrimental to your natural health but also to your soul. For how long will you weep? For how long will you continue to suffer? Many have experienced this for years and are truly tired of approaching the Holy Throne of God for mercy and forgiveness on account of these very sins. Satan is wicked! How do you expect him to abandon what works, who does that? The frequent commission of these sins is what attracted the presence of this spirit entities to our lives. We opened the spiritual gateways that

gave them legal access and dominion over our lives. They have taken advantage of our minds and have created a system of fortification around our minds that give them the capability and liberty to do with us as they please. This is the reason for that helplessness that you experience whenever you are pushed to commit those evil acts. You have been bound and can never be free unless you encounter real power! Demons are not begged to leave, they are forced to bow out through power. I tell you, not everybody is like this. Some have come in contact with real supernatural power that has made them insurmountable and victorious over these spiritual diseases. Divinity is at work in them. These persons were once like you; weaklings that had no hope. Now, they have come to the understanding that it is vain to on rely on mere determination and willpower, for they never cease to fail. Truly, there is a grace and unless you experience this grace, you will never believe our saying as true and real. Glory to the Father who have given us victory in Christ Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 6:9

Let's Begin today's reflection with this powerful song: "My deliverer is coming, my deliverer is standing by (2X)."

Sing also: "My Savior, He can move the mountains, My God is mighty to save, He is mighty to save, forever author of salvation, He rose and conquered the grave, Jesus conquered the grave." Indeed Jesus is victorious! Alleluia! It is in our weakness that the strength of God is revealed. Do not be downcast, my beloved, you will indeed triumph! 2 Cor. 3:17 says, "Now, "the Lord" is that Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is present, there is freedom." Dear, do you believe that God can save you? His Word assures us of His salvific power in the book of Joel 2:32. It says, "But who has the lord for help shall be saved..." He reveals to us again His saving power in the book of Psalms 91:14-16: "I will save those who love me and will protect those who acknowledge me as Lord. When they call to me, I will answer them; when they are in trouble, I will be with them. I will rescue them and honour them. I will reward them with long life; I will save them." Friend, do you believe in the truthfulness of God's word? Do you trust that Jesus can draw you out from this dark pit? Forget what the devil is saying to you now. It is very true that you might have been suffering for years but that means nothing to God. God is almighty and can change your life in a moment if he wills. Psalms 30:5 says, "...Tears may flow in the night, but joy comes in the morning." It doesn't matter what you might have undergone for months, years or even decades, all that matters now is your trust in power and working of the Spirit. Nothing is new under the sun. Many have experienced even worse than your present situation are now enjoying true victory and peace. The world may be wallowing in these sins but today you have chosen to live no more for the flesh, to follow the pathway of the Spirit and live your whole life for God. This is indeed a great and remarkable resolution and heaven rejoice over you. You know you have gained true victory not when you force yourself not to watch or view them again but when the urge to do has completely been eroded by the grace of God through the Holy Spirit. It is then that you will know that indeed true victory exist. You will wave pornography and masturbation goodbye and they will wave you back. Now, how can this victory become yours in experience? These are what you have to do: firstly, you have to come to a point where you sincerely desire the help and salvation of God. You

must willingly choose to do away with those sins and live only for nothing but God. Secondly, you must come to understand the implication of what Christ did on the cross; He nailed to the cross, sin and the flesh. Even though sin and the flesh were destroyed on the cross, you still have a daily and life obligation. What is this obligation? Subduing the flesh! This, the Spirit helps us to do and it is only by this can we live for the spirit. You are a Slave to pornography and masturbation because you are still a slave to the flesh. Believers must subdue the flesh, the domain through which evil spirits find expression, only if they want to be free. How then can we constantly crucify the flesh? By walking in the spirit. You must allow the Holy Spirit to govern and reign over your life. Great men have plied this path, they have walked this road and are now masters and generals in the realm of the immortals. This looks hard but it is the only way that the supremacy of the spirit can find expression and manifestation in our lives. Don't you know that through pornography and masturbation these evil spirits feed? This is the very reason they don't want to let you go. This also is the reason you can't go far in the Spirit/ in life, for through the commission of these sins, they rob you of your spiritual inheritance and keep you as captive. The atmosphere which these sins create keep them comfortable and peaceful (the flesh is a spiritual niche for demons and evil spirits). If you aren't ready to Journey through with the Spirit, then, forget about liberation. Our victory have been purchased in Christ through His substitutionary death on the tree of Calvary and this victory will only become our experience not by desiring to be free or torturing yourself or choosing not to make use of the internet but by submitting wholly to the Spirit of the Living God. St. Paul says, "...Let the Spirit direct your lives, and you will not satisfy the desires of the human nature. For what our human nature wants is opposed to what the Spirit wants, and what the Spirit wants is opposed to what our human nature wants. These two are enemies, and this means that you cannot do what you want to do. If the Spirit leads you, then you are not subject to the Law. What human nature does is quite plain. It shows itself in immoral, filthy, and indecent actions; in worship of idols and witchcraft. People become enemies and they fight; they become jealous, angry, and ambitious. They separate into parties and groups; they are envious, get drunk, have orgies, and do other things like these. I warn you now as I have before: those who do these things will not possess the Kingdom of God. But the Spirit produces love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, humility, and self-control. There is no law against such things as these. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have put to death their human nature with all its passions and desires. The Spirit has given us life; he must also control our lives." (Gal. 5:16-26). This is where our victory lies! It is the Spirit that gives us self control, He destroys all ungodly appetites and directs us in all that is good. When this happens, you become fearless at what you once feared. Lust that ate you up then becomes

nothing to you. You are then governed by love and are not pulled in or enticed by indecent pictures and videos no more. No longer can masturbation raise its ugly head! No longer can the flesh subdue you! Let's conclude with the words of St. James and St. Paul, "So then, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you... Avoid the passions of youth, and strive for righteousness, faith, love, and peace, together with those who with a pure heart call out to the Lord for help." (James 4:7 and 2 Tim 2:22). Tomorrow is going to be a prayer session!

### How to Recite the Chaplet

The Chaplet of Mercy is recited using ordinary rosary beads of five decades. The Chaplet is preceded by two opening prayers from the Diary of Saint Faustina and followed by a closing prayer.

#### **1. Make the Sign of the Cross**

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### **2. Optional Opening Prayers**

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat three times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

#### **3. Our Father**

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

#### **4. Hail Mary**

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.

#### **5. The Apostle's Creed**

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.
